Title: Simmons v. Colonial Life & Accident Ins. Co., et al.

Facts: This fraud/bad-faith lawsuit concerned the sale of a long-term disability rider and a subsequent denial of benefits under that rider. The morning before trial a confidential settlement was reached and the Defendant asked that all corporate depositions and all documents, training manuals, claims manuals, coding charts and operating flow charts be returned. Mark Wolfe of Boteler, Finley & Wolfe and Pat Sigler, Esq. represented the victim in the lawsuit.
